



Community Garden Sustainability Fund

Background Information

Since 2010, Grow Pittsburgh, the Western Pennsylvania Conservancy (WPC), and Allegheny County Economic Development have been working together to start new food gardens through the City Growers and Allegheny Grows programs. This year, Grow Pittsburgh and WPC are also offering technical assistance and materials to support the efforts of *existing* community food gardens through the Community Garden Sustainability Fund.

This fund is intended to assist existing community food gardens with projects that contribute to the sustainability of their gardens. For instance, groups can apply for materials such as fencing, raised beds, compost and topsoil, signage, rain barrels, and services like tilling or soil testing.

Selected projects will be awarded in mid-June and completed between June and October.

Who is Eligible?

In order to be eligible for support, a community garden must:

- 1) Be located in Allegheny County
- 2) Have a minimum of 6 organized and motivated gardeners in the garden group
- 3) Have an already functioning food-growing site
- 4) Have written permission by property owner to garden on the designated site. *Preferred* ownership by a non-profit or municipality. If privately owned, please provide proof of insurance and demonstrate how the garden is serving the public.
- 5) Note: Current 2014 City Growers and Allegheny Grows program participants are <u>not</u> eligible for this assistance. However, we do encourage graduated gardens of these programs to apply.

Proposals of up to \$6,000 will be considered, though smaller projects are more likely to be awarded.
