Summary of Position:

The Urban Farm Apprenticeship Coordinator is responsible for the day to day activities of Grow Pittsburgh's Urban Farm Apprenticeship (UFA) Program, a 10 month intensive training program at three urban farm sites which graduates aspiring new farmers annually. The coordinator, in partnership with the Director of Educational Programming, Director of Agricultural Production, and the Braddock Farm and Frick and Shiloh Farm Manager, will also be responsible for the planning, development and implementation of a long-term program plan for the UFA program. In addition, the Coordinator will be responsible for maintaining relationships with key food and agriculture partners in the region and beyond.

Responsibilities:

<u>Planning</u>

- Research and evaluate reputable apprentice programs across the country as Grow Pittsburgh seeks to enhance its apprentice program and partnerships
- Work with Director of Educational Programming to develop a more formalized curriculum for the 10 month program
- Serve as primary recruiter for new apprentices, including targeted outreach to partner agricultural organizations, technical schools and programs and the general public
- Create opportunities in partnership with the Pennsylvania Association for Sustainable Agriculture (PASA) for apprentices to graduate to apprenticeships and/or jobs on larger farms

• Serve as primary liaison for Grow Pittsburgh to local partner organizations developing opportunities for new and beginning farmers

Program

- Coordinate yearly hiring process for new apprentices
- Manage day to day aspects of seasonal program and serve as primary contact for current and graduated apprentices
- Perform regularly scheduled check-ins with sites managers and apprentices, focused on educational goals
- Plan, execute and participate in field trips, workshops and other educational activities for apprentices throughout the season
- Arrange for individual opportunities based on needs and interests of apprentices, including attendance at various conferences
- Develop detailed apprentice handbook to be used annually by incoming students
- Develop and maintain relevant data and metrics related to the UFA program
- Ensure program participants are connected to the organization as a whole through the development of learning opportunities across programs

 Assist farm managers on-site at busy times of the year, including but not limited to spring planting and seedling sales

- Experience with field-based educational programming preferred
- Experience with new program development preferred
