| Flowers | Notes | Description |

| Jewel Mix Nasturtiums | Yellow, Orange, Red | Bright colors: yellow, pink, red and orange. The edible flowers are popular for salads and as a garnish; the peppery leaves are also very flavorful. A colorful garden favorite. |
| Crackerjack Marigold | Yellow and Orange | Majestic 4" blooms in tangerine orange, rich gold, and lemony yellow. They make radiant long-lasting cut flowers and are easy to grow . |
| Benary's Giant Zinnias | Pink, Orange, Yellow | Benary's Giant Zinnias feature large, double blossoms approximately 4–5" in diameter, in multiple, magnificent colors. Vigorous all-season producers hold up well in summer rain and heat |

| Autumn Beauty Sunflower | Purple | | Bold, beautiful flowers up to 8" across. Bright yellow, bronze, and purple shades with some bi-colors. |

| Big Smile Sunflower | Yellow | | Attractive in small beds, containers, and 4-6" pots. 3-6" blooms are bright golden-yellow with a black center. Also known as common sunflower and annual sunflower. Branching |
| Purple Coneflower | Purple | Perennial | A popular perennial with smooth, 2-5 ft. stems and long-lasting, lavender flowers. An attractive perennial with purple (rarely white), drooping rays surrounding a spiny, brownish central disk. |
| Goldsturm Rudbeckia | Yellow | Perennial | Dazzling mounds of yellow flowers with a deep brown center. Very long blooming. Not bothered by insects or drought. |
| Sweet Alyssum | White | Self seeds | Easy to grow annual, very heat and drought tolerant. Not cold tolerant, but able to self sow and provide year after year of bright white flowers in milder winters. |
| Calendula | Yellow and Orange | Self seeds | An early and bright medley of single and double orange, gold, yellow and cream-colored flowers. Well-branched plants with tall, straight stems great for cutting, with continuous blooms all summer. Fresh petals are beautiful in salads and as cake decorations |
| Chammomile | White | Perennial | Popular tea plant. Harvest and dry the flowers to make a nourishing herbal tea. Does well in pots. Prolific flowers. |

| African Blue | Very disease resistant | | Beautiful purple green coloring. Can be used in flower arrangements as well as in any culinary dish. Disease resistant. Perennial if brought indoors. |

| Ailsa Craig Onions | Yellow Onions | | Large, yellow, round, Spanish-style onion. Early and cold-weather tolerant. |
| Winterbor Kale | | | 24-36" plant with curly blue-green leaves. Hardy to very cold temperatures. Produces spring through fall. |
| Lacinato Kale | | | 18-24" plant with dark green wrinkled leaves. Leaves are sturdy yet tender. |
| Champion Collards | | | Rich, dark-green color with long, broad, wavy, tender leaves |
| Bay Meadows Broccoli | | | Beautiful, blue-green, well-domed heads. This widely adapted variety has performed extremely well under stressful conditions from both spring and summer plantings. |
| Tendersweet Cabbage | | | Midsize, flat heads stand well without splitting. Tender leaves are very thin, sweet, and crisp - perfect for coleslaw or stir-fries. The leaves, used whole or cut into squares, are also suitable for wraps. |

| Orient Express | Asian | Asian eggplant. Thin, 8-10" glossy black fruits. Very few seeds. Very productive. |
| Galine | Italian | Very glossy, uniform, black fruits are 6-7" long by 3-4" in diameter. Strong plants produce early, firm fruits. High yielding. |
| Summer Vegetables | Notes | Description |
| Spineless Beauty Zucchini | Green | Dark green zucchini, bush-like plant with no spines. |
| Marketmore 76 Cucumber | Green | Productive, dark green, uniform 8-9" long slicing cucumbers. |
| Sugar Baby Watermelon | Red inside | This widely adapted heirloom variety is solid, dark green on the outside with a bright red, firm and fine-grained flesh that is super sweet. 8 to 10 pound fruit. |
| Goldie Ground Cherry | Yellow | Averaging 3/4" in diameter. Use these sweet berries fresh in salads, pies, dessert toppings or preserves. |
| Toma Verde Tomatillo | Green | Early-maturing, large, flat-round green fruits. Use in salsa. Need at least two for good pollination. |

| Sun Gold | Gold | Hybrid | Intense fruity flavor. Exceptionally sweet, bright tangerine-orange cherry tomatoes leave customers begging for more. Vigorous plants start yielding early and bear right through the season. Tendency to split. Indeterminate |
| Supersweet 100 | Red | Hybrid | Hybrid Indeterminate. Resistant to verticillium wilt (V), fusarium wilt (F), and nematodes (N). Produces all season long until first frost. They are perfect for snacking, salads, and juicing. |
| Tomatoes, Container | Notes | Туре | Description |
| Tiny Tim | Red | Heirloom | A heavy yielder with clusters of fine flavored, red fruit that are about one half inch in diameter. Can be grown as a potted plant anytime of the year. Good for small gardens, patios, or apartment dwellers. Determinate |
| Glacier | Red | Hybrid | Semi-determinate. Loads of round, 2-3-inch, red to slightly orange fruit are produced on compact, potato-leafed plants to 3 feet tall. Use in salads or in colorful tomato salads! |
| Mountain Princess | Red | WV Heirloom | This early tomato from West Virginia has been grown for generations in the mountain climate of the state. Bright red and mildly flavored, the 8 ounce fruit is round, smooth and solid. A good short |

| Tomatoes, Red Slicers | Notes | Туре | Description |
| Estiva | Red | Hybrid | 6-7 oz. tomatoes are resistant to cracking and remarkably uniform. Estiva produces fully-loaded trusses of crimson fruit over a long season, and responds well to heat and drought stress. Disease resistant. Indeterminate. |
| Rose de Berne | Red | Heirloom | Beautiful, nicely-shaped 4-to 8-oz fruit are a rose-pink color and have an excellent sweet flavor. |
| Bonny Best | Red | Heirloom | Medium-sized fruit are round, red, meaty and loaded with flavor. A good producer that makes a fine slicer too. Averaging about five ounces, they deliver a mildly tart flavor that one would expect from a classic red tomato. |
| New Girl | Red | Hybrid | Early Determinate. Fruits resist over-ripening, so keep longer with no decrease in flavor after reaching the fully-ripe stage. Plants definitely need staking; this tomato grows as tall as 6 feet and is disease resistant(verticillium wilt (V) and fusarium wilt). |
| Tomatoes, Paste | Notes | Туре | Description |
| Roma, Monica | Red | Hybrid | Determinate plum tomato. Great to chop for salsa or diced tomatoes. Meaty tomato, good in sauces. |
| San Marzano | Red | Heirloom | Classic Italian paste tomato with rich, complex, sweet flavor essential for making traditional sauces and whole canned tomatoes. The large plants produce loads of small, elongated red tomatoes late in the season and need to be staked. Indeterminate |
| Tomatoes, Heirloom - Large Fruit | Notes | Туре | Description |

| Mortgage Lifter | Red | PA Heirloom | This huge heirloom beefsteak (up to 4 lb.; average 2 1/2 lb.) consistently wins taste-tests. Developed in the 1930s by a gardener who planted the four biggest varieties he knew and crossed one with pollen from the other three. |

| Brandywine | Pink | Heirloom | The classic heirloom tomato. Large fruits, often over 1 lb., have a deep pink skin and smooth red flesh. A medium-tall, potato-leaf plant. |
| Cherokee purple | Purple | Heirloom | Famously rich flavor and texture make this a colorful favorite among heirloom enthusiasts. Medium-large, flattened globe, 8-12 oz. fruits. Multi color interior ranges from purple to brown to green. Relatively short vines. Indeterminate. |
| Pineapple | Striped, Red and Yellow | Heirloom | Medium to large, variably ribbed-shoulder tomatoes are shaded yellow and red. The marbled interior looks beautiful sliced. Complex, fruity flavor and smooth texture. Medium-tall vines. |
| Yellow Brandywine | Yellow | Heirloom | The potato leafed vines produce golden-yellow, large fruits weighing up to two pounds. The tomatoes have a creamy texture and an excellent, intense flavor that can be a bit more on the tart side. Indeterminate |
| Tomatoes, Heirloom - Small to Medium Size Fruit | Notes | Туре | Description |
| Arkansas Traveler | Pink | Heirloom | Deep pink when ripe, the round 6-8 oz. fruits' artful balance of sweetness and tartness accounts for its standing as one of the very best heirloom varieties. Does well in poor soil. Disease-resistant, indeterminate vines. |
| Garden Peach | Fuzzy Yellow | Heirloom | A unique Heirloom. The small, velvety-skinned 2-3 oz. fruits have rich full flavor. The prolific vines unleash multitudinous 3-4" round fruits with |

| Black Prince | Purple | Heirloom | Black Heirloom Tomato, Indeterminate. The small, dark-red, slightly pear-shaped fruits begin maturing a little more than 2 months after planting. Vigorous vines grow best in tall cages. |
| Green Zebra | Striped Green | Heirloom | High-yielding indeterminate plants produce oodles of 1 1/2-2 1/2" fruits. emerald green skin, dark green vertical stripes, and gently flavorful green flesh. |
