Flowers	Notes	Type	Description
<b>Crackerjack Marigold</b>	Yellow and Orange	Annual	Majestic 4" blooms in tangerine orange, rich gold, and lemony yellow. They make radiant long-lasting cut flowers and are easy to grow .
<b>Benary's Giant Zinnias</b>	Pink, Orange, Yellow	Annual	Benary's Giant Zinnias feature large, double blossoms approximately 4–5" in diameter, in multiple, magnificent colors. Vigorous all-season producers; hold up well in summer rain and heat
<b>Jazzy Mix Zinnias</b>	Red, Orange, Yellow	Annual	Attractive, fully-double and semi double blooms are 1-2" in size. Bright, earthy tones; Bi-color blooms
<b>Autumn Beauty Sunflower</b>	Yellow, Bronze, Purple	Annual	Bold, beautiful flowers up to 8" across. Bright yellow, bronze, and purple shades with some bi-colors.

<b>Big Smile Sunflower</b>	Yellow	Annual	Attractive in small beds and containers. 3-6" blooms are bright golden-yellow with a black center. Branching.
<b>Double Click Cosmos</b>	Light Purple to Pink	Annual	Hardy, tolerant of drought and low fertility, subject to very little disease or pest pressure. Attracts bees. 3-4' tall.

Flowers, edible	Notes	Type	Description
<b>Bachelor Buttons</b>	Blue, Purple, Pink, White	Annual	Easy to grow, great for cut-flowers and beds. Wiry stems. 3' tall.
<b>Tangerine Gem Marigold</b>	Orange	Annual	Tiny, fragrant, deep orange flowers. Delicious, citrusy taste. Long-blooming, compact plants.
<b>Swiss Giant Pansy</b>	Yellow, Blue, Purple, White	Annual	Prolific, large velvety flowers. Compact quick growing plants, great for containers.
<b>Jewel Mix Nasturtiums</b>	Yellow, Orange, Red	Annual	Bright colors. The edible flowers are popular for salads and as a garnish; the peppery leaves are also very flavorful. A colorful garden favorite.
<b>Anise Hyssop</b>	Purple	Perennial	Sweet, licorice flavored leaves and flowers. Abundant blooms are very attractive to pollinators.

Flowers, medicinal	Notes	Type	Description
<b>Purple Coneflower</b>	Purple	Perennial	A popular perennial with smooth, 2-5 ft. stems and long-lasting, lavender flowers with center cone. Also known as Echinacea.
<b>Calendula</b>	Yellow and Orange	Self seeds	An early and bright medley of single and double orange and yellow flowers. Branched plants with blooms all summer. Fresh petals are beautiful in salads and dried are used for treating skin conditions.
<b>Chamomile</b>	White	Will not overwinter most years	Popular tea plant. Harvest and dry the flowers to make a soothing herbal tea. Does well in pots.

Herbs, Basil	Notes		Description
Italian Basil	Resistant to Fusarium	Annual	Standard Italian basil. Large plant with shiny, dark green leaves. Sweet flavor & high yields.
Red Rubin	Red leaf	Annual	Dark purple, 3" leaves. Great flavor. Can be used in teas.
Spicy Globe	Tiny leaves	Annual	Miniature variety, great for containers. Grows in rounded, bush shape. Strong and slightly spicy flavor.
Thai	Purple and green leaf	Annual	2" green leaves and purple stems. Sweet, anise-like flavor great for Thai food.
Mrs. Burns' Lemon	Small Leaves	Annual, Heirloom	Medium-sized bright green leaves; intense lemony fragrance.
Holy Basil	Also known as Tulsi	Annual	Used in Thai food and teas, digestive and immune support.
Pesto Perpetuo	Variegated white to green leaf	Annual	Bright green leaves with cream and light green borders. Sweet, basil scent and taste.
African Blue	Very disease resistant	Annual	Beautiful purple green coloring. Can be used in flower arrangements as well as in any culinary dish. Perennial if brought indoors.
Herbs, Lemon	Notes		Description
Lemon Verbena	Great for tea	Will not overwinter most years	12-24" shrub-like plant. Leaves have strong lemon aroma and flavor.
Lemon Balm	White flowers in summer	Perennial	Vigorously spreading plant. Strong lemon flavor for tea.
Herbs, European	Notes	Type	Description
Italian Flat Leaf Parsley	Can be used fresh or dried	Annual	Classic parsley. Upright, productive variety. Good flavor.
Double Curled Parsley	Tolerates heat and cuttings	Annual	Double and triple curled leaves. Good flavor.
Oregano, Greek	Dark green leaves and white flowers	Perennial	Essential for Italian food. Strong aroma and flavor. Very hardy

<b>Arp Rosemary</b>	Upright	Will not overwinter most years	Classic rosemary. Upright plant. Pine-scented, resinous leaves.
<b>Blue Rain Rosemary</b>	Creeping	Will not overwinter most years	Fragrant rosemary with a creeping growth habit. Good for containers.
<b>German Winter Thyme</b>	Upright	Perennial	Good flavor and yield, winter hardy.
<b>Creeping Thyme</b>	Creeping	Perennial	Ground cover. Edible leaves and light purple flowers.
<b>Lavender, Provence</b>	Scent deters pests; mice, mosquitoes	Perennial	Compact habit. Fragrant purple flowers. Winter-hardy.
<b>Broadleaf Sage</b>	Attracts pollinators	Perennial	Fuzzy, oval leaves on shrub-like plant. Purple blooms in early summer.
<b>French Tarragon</b>	Use fresh or dried	Perennial	Thin, vining stems with delicate leaves. Anise flavor.
<b>Herbs, Mints</b>	<b>Notes</b>	<b>Type</b>	<b>Description</b>
<b>Spearmint</b>	Fast growing	Perennial	Great for tea, sauces, and salads. Vigorous spreading habit - plant in container to keep under control.
<b>Peppermint</b>	Fast growing	Perennial	Great for teas and garnishes. Vigorous spreading habit.
<b>Catnip</b>	White Flowers	Perennial	The purrrfect plant for your pet. May grow to 4 feet tall. Good addition to teas.
<b>Herbs, The Rest</b>	<b>Notes</b>	<b>Type</b>	<b>Description</b>
<b>Cilantro</b>	Self Seeds	Annual	Essential for many dishes. Leaves are called cilantro, seeds are called coriander. Flowers are edible too!
<b>Fernleaf Dill</b>	Self seeds	Annual	Dwarf plant, 26-32". Very slow to bolt.
<b>Bouquet Dill</b>	Self seeds	Annual	Good production of seeds, flowers & leaves.
<b>Chives</b>	Eaten fresh or dried	Perennial	Tubular leaves. Delicate onion flavor. Delicious flowers!
<b>Pineapple Sage</b>	Use for cold drinks or salads	Will not overwinter most years	Light green leaves are pineapple scented. Showy red flowers that pollinators love.
<b>Stevia</b>	Sweet!	Annual in our area	Used to sweeten teas and drinks

Spring Vegetables	Notes	Type	Description
<b>Jersey Knight Asparagus</b>	Resistance to rust and fusarium	Perennial	Good variety for heavy soils, begin harvesting second year.
<b>Winterbor Kale</b>	Hardy to very cold temps.	Annual	24-36" plant with curly blue-green leaves. Produces spring through late fall.
<b>Lacinato Kale</b>	Also called Dino kale	Annual	18-24" plant with dark green wrinkled leaves. Leaves are sturdy yet tender.
<b>Green King Broccoli</b>	Side shoots harvestable	Annual	Vigorous plants bear thick blue-green domed heads. Stands heat well.
<b>Bright Lights Chard</b>	Rainbow Colors	Annual	Multi-colored stems with glossy green leaves. Leaves & stems edible.
<b>Gourmet Lettuce Mix</b>	Mix of colors	Annual	Unique mix of shapes and colors. Good shelf life.
<b>Arugula</b>	Peppery leaves	Annual	Spicy salad green. Tender leaves. Cold tolerant.
Strawberries	Notes	Type	Description
<b>Seacape</b>	Red	Everbearing	Flowers and fruit all season. The berries are large, prolific, and have good flavor. Does well in containers

Summer Vegetables	Notes	Type	Description
<b>Spineless Beauty Zucchini</b>	Green	Annual	Dark green zucchini, bush-like plant
<b>Marketmore 76 Cucumber</b>	Slicing	Annual	Productive, dark green, uniform 8-9" long slicing cucumbers.
<b>Sugar Baby Watermelon</b>	Super sweet Heirloom	Annual	Widely adapted heirloom variety. Solid, dark green on the outside with a bright red, firm flesh. 8 to 10 pound fruit.
<b>Aunt Molly Ground Cherry</b>	Yellow	Annual	Heirloom, small, sweet fruits with a papery husk. Drops to the ground when ripe! Use in salads, pies, dessert toppings or preserves.
<b>Toma Verde Tomatillo</b>	Green	Annual	Early-maturing, large, flat-round green fruits. Use in salsa. Need at least two for good pollination.

<b>Eggplant</b>	<b>Notes</b>	<b>Type</b>	<b>Description</b>
<b>Fairytale</b>	Purple and White	Annual	Mini eggplant, can be harvested in clusters. No bitterness, few seeds
<b>Orient Express</b>	Asian	Annual	Thin, 8-10" glossy black fruits. Very few seeds. Very productive.
<b>Galine</b>	Italian	Annual	Very glossy, uniform, black fruits are 6-7" long by 3-4" in diameter. Strong plants produce early, firm fruits. High yielding.

<b>Tomatoes, Cherry</b>	<b>Notes</b>	<b>Type</b>	<b>Description</b>
<b>Black Cherry</b>	Purple	Heirloom	Yields plentiful clusters of round tomatoes that are deep purplish brown. Flavor is juicy and sweet. Indeterminate.
<b>Juliet</b>	Red	Heirloom	Cherry tomato sized plum tomato. Delicious tomato flavor for salads, salsa, and pasta sauce. Very disease resistant.
<b>Sunpeach</b>	Pink	Hybrid	Sister variety to Sun Gold - not as tangy and acidic. Pink with very sweet flavor. High yielding, resistant to cracking.
<b>Sun Gold</b>	Gold	Hybrid	Exceptionally sweet, bright tangerine cherry tomatoes. Vigorous plants start yielding early and bear right through the season but have tendency to split. Indeterminate
<b>Supersweet 100</b>	Red	Hybrid	Hybrid Indeterminate. Resistant to verticillium wilt, fusarium wilt, and nematodes. Produces all season long
<b>Pink Tiger</b>	Striped	Open pollinated	Elongated pink tomato with orange striping. Won our taste test at Shiloh!
<b>Tomatoes, Container</b>	<b>Notes</b>	<b>Type</b>	<b>Description</b>
<b>Tidy Treats</b>	Red	Hybrid	High-yielding, compact cherry tomatoes. Dwarf indeterminate.
<b>Glacier</b>	Red	Hybrid	Semi-determinate. High-yield. Round, 2-3-inch fruit are produced on compact, potato-leafed plants
<b>Mountain Princess</b>	Red	WV Heirloom	Bright red and mildly flavored, the 8 ounce fruit is round, smooth and solid. A good short season variety that is also very productive.

Tomatoes, Slicers	Notes	Type	Description
<b>Big Beef</b>	Red	Hybrid	Large, globe shaped fruits, that ripen early for their size. Lots of disease resistance. Great flavor!
<b>Rose de Berne</b>	Pink	Heirloom	4-to 8-oz fruit are a rose-pink color and have an excellent sweet flavor.
<b>New Girl</b>	Red	Hybrid	Early semi-determinate. Fruits resist over-ripening. Require staking. Disease resistant.
Tomatoes, Paste	Notes	Type	Description
<b>Roma</b>	Red	Hybrid	Determinate tomato. Meaty tomato, good in sauces and for dicing. Great disease resistant.
<b>San Marzano</b>	Slightly larger than Roma, resists cracking	Heirloom	Classic Italian paste tomato good for preserving. The large plants produce loads of tomatoes late in the season and need to be staked. Indeterminate.
Tomatoes, Heirloom - Large Fruit	Notes	Type	Description
<b>Mortgage Lifter</b>	Red	WV Heirloom	Average 2 1/2 lb. Consistently wins taste-tests for it's rich, sweet taste.
<b>Brandywine</b>	Pink	Heirloom	The classic heirloom tomato. Large fruits, often over 1 lb., have a deep pink skin and smooth red flesh. A medium-tall, potato-leaf plant.
<b>Cherokee Purple</b>	Purple	Heirloom	Famously rich flavor and texture make this a colorful favorite among heirloom enthusiasts. Medium-large, flattened globe, 8-12 oz. fruits. Multi color interior ranges from purple to brown to green. Relatively short vines. Indeterminate.
<b>Pineapple</b>	Red and Yellow	Heirloom	Medium to large, variably ribbed-shoulder tomatoes are shaded yellow and red. Marbled interior. Fruity flavor and smooth texture.
<b>Yellow Brandywine</b>	Yellow	Heirloom	The potato leafed vines produce golden-yellow, large fruits weighing up to two pounds. Creamy texture and intense flavor that can be a bit tart. Indeterminate

Tomatoes, Heirloom - Small to Medium Size Fruit	Notes	Type	Description
Arkansas Traveler	Pink	Heirloom	Deep pink when ripe, 6-8 oz. Balance of sweetness and tartness. Stands as one of the very best heirloom varieties. Does well in poor soil. Disease-resistant, indeterminate vines. *We save these seeds!*
Garden Peach	Fuzzy Yellow	Heirloom	A unique heirloom. Prolific vines produce small, velvety peachy-yellow skin, 2-3 oz. fruits. Indeterminate.
Black Prince	Purple	Heirloom	Black Heirloom tomato, Indeterminate. Medium sized fruit with coloring from red to black. Vigorous vines grow best in tall cages. Delicious smoky-sweet flavor.
Green Zebra	Striped Green	Heirloom	High-yielding. Indeterminate. Produce 1.5-2.5" fruits. Emerald green skin, dark green vertical stripes, and gently flavorful green flesh.
