Saturdays: 9:00 am – 3:00 pm

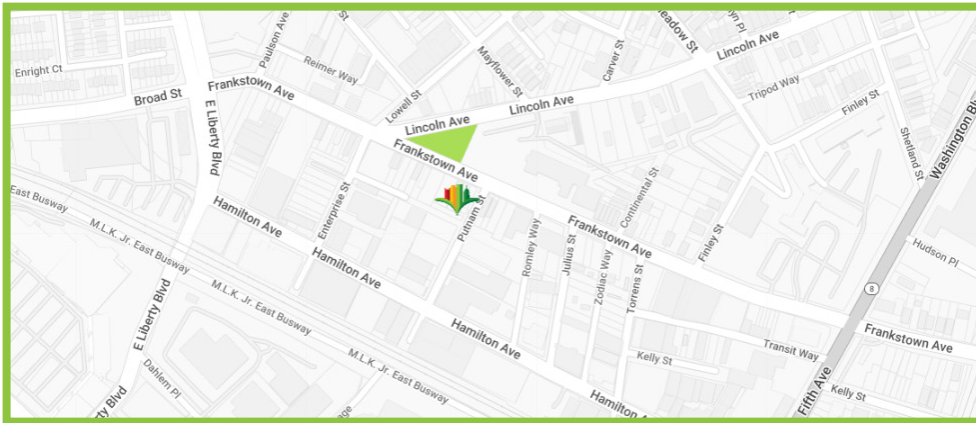

The GRC can lend a hand. We aim to reduce barriers to growing food by making it easier for you to access the tools and supplies needed to grow beautiful and productive home and community gardens. How to sign up

Eligibility

Download and complete the application form provided on the website. Application forms also available in person at the GRC.

Bring proof that you are at least 18 years old and live in Allegheny County.

- Driver's License or State ID
- Utility Bill or Lease Agreement

Prices and Perks

The GRC provides both efficiency of resources and a reliable community to its members. We give everyone, no matter their income, an opportunity to participate in this tool lending library. Our membership fees are flexible and determined by an individual or organization's ability to pay what is possible on a sliding scale.

Individual:

For home gardeners, individual community gardeners and small-scale businesses.

- Sliding scale \$20-\$160, suggested amount \$80
- 5 buckets each of compost, topsoil and mulch each month
- 1 free straw bale per year

Group:

For community gardens, community farms, organizations and food pantry gardens who are serving multiple community members.

- Sliding scale \$80-\$300, suggested amount \$160
- 10 buckets each of compost, topsoil and mulch each month
- 4 free straw bales per year

Rental Timeframes:

- Hand tools have a 1-week rental period.
- Power tools are due next business day.

Late fees vary and prices are subject to change.
